Composition:

Each capsule contains:

- **Acebrophylline** – 100 mg

Pharmacological Action:

Acebrophylline is a bronchodilator and mucoregulator, combining properties of ambroxol and theophylline-7-acetate. It functions by:

- **Bronchodilation:** Relaxing bronchial smooth muscles, reducing bronchospasm, and improving airflow.
- **Mucoregulation:** Reducing mucus viscosity, which enhances mucus clearance and helps in respiratory tract secretion clearance.
- **Anti-inflammatory:** Inhibits the release of pro-inflammatory cytokines, reducing inflammation in the respiratory tract.

Indications:

Acebrophylline 100 mg capsules are indicated for the management of:

- **Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)**
- **Chronic Bronchitis**
- **Asthma**
- **Other Obstructive Airway Diseases**

Dosage and Administration:

- **Recommended Dose:** One capsule twice daily or as directed by the physician.
- **Administration:** Swallow the capsule whole with water, preferably after meals to avoid gastrointestinal discomfort.
- **Duration of Use:** Use as prescribed by the healthcare provider. Avoid abrupt

Precautions:

- **Pregnancy & Lactation:** Use only if prescribed, as the safety of acebrophylline in pregnancy and lactation is not fully established.
- **Liver & Kidney Impairment:** Dose adjustment may be necessary; consult with a healthcare provider.
- **Use with Caution:** Patients with cardiovascular conditions should use acebrophylline cautiously, as it can occasionally lead to palpitations.

Contraindications:

- Known hypersensitivity to acebrophylline or other methylxanthine derivatives.
- Patients with severe hepatic or renal impairment unless monitored closely.

Adverse Reactions:

- **Common:** Nausea, vomiting, stomach discomfort, heartburn, and dizziness.
- **Rare but Serious:** Palpitations, allergic skin reactions, and difficulty breathing. Report severe adverse effects to a healthcare provider.

Drug Interactions:

- **Avoid combining with other methylxanthines** (such as theophylline) as it may increase the risk of toxicity.
- **Caution with other bronchodilators or antihistamines** which may enhance side effects.

Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C, protected from moisture and light.
- Keep out of reach of children.
