Injection

Atropine Sulfate Injection 1mg/ml



Bradycardia Treatment

Effectively increases heart rate by inhibiting parasympathetic activity.



Reduces Secretions

Decreases salivary, tracheobronchial, and gastric secretions, useful in pre-anesthesia.



Mydriatic Effect

Causes pupil dilation for diagnostic and ophthalmic procedures.



Bronchodilation

Relieves bronchospasm by relaxing bronchial smooth muscles.



Emergency & Antidotal Use

Used in organophosphate poisoning and other emergency situations.
