

Amrofly Cream

Amorolfine I.P. 0.25% w/w Cream

Amorolfine cream is an antifungal medication used to treat a wide range of fungal skin infections. It works by inhibiting the growth of fungi, effectively managing symptoms and promoting healing.

Composition:

- **Amorolfine I.P. 0.25% w/w:** A topical antifungal agent belonging to the morpholine class, which disrupts fungal cell membrane synthesis.
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Uses:

- **Fungal Skin Infections:**
 - Athlete's foot (Tinea pedis)
 - Ringworm (Tinea corporis)
 - Jock itch (Tinea cruris)
 - Skin candidiasis
 - **Other Dermatophyte or Yeast Infections:**
 - Pityriasis versicolor
 - Nail fold infections caused by fungi
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Mechanism of Action:

Amorolfine inhibits ergosterol synthesis, a vital component of fungal cell membranes. This results in weakened membranes, inhibiting fungal growth and leading to their eventual death.

Dosage & Administration:

- **How to Use:**
 1. Clean and dry the affected area thoroughly before application.
 2. Apply a thin layer of the cream to the infected area and surrounding skin.
 3. Gently rub it in until fully absorbed.
 - **Frequency:** Use once or twice daily or as directed by your healthcare provider.
 - **Duration:** Continue treatment as prescribed, even if symptoms improve, to prevent recurrence.
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Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Amorolfine or any of the ingredients in the formulation.
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Side Effects:

- Mild irritation, redness, or itching at the site of application.
 - Rarely, allergic reactions such as rash or swelling.
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Precautions:

- For external use only. Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, or mucous membranes.
- Discontinue use and consult a doctor if severe irritation or allergic reaction occurs.
- Wash hands thoroughly after applying the cream.

- **Do not use on open wounds or broken skin.**
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Storage:

- **Store at a temperature below 30°C in a cool, dry place.**
 - **Keep away from direct sunlight and moisture.**
 - **Keep out of reach of children.**
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Note: Use under medical guidance. If there is no improvement in symptoms after 2-4 weeks of use, consult your healthcare provider.
