Information For the User Aztreonam (2gm) Injection

Dosage Form: Injection

Composition:

Each vial contains: Aztreonam IP 2 g

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated for the treatment of moderate to severe infections caused by susceptible Gram-negative bacteria.

Effective in urinary tract infections, lower respiratory tract infections, intra-abdominal infections, gynecological infections, skin and soft tissue infections, and septicemia.

It helps by inhibiting bacterial growth and promoting rapid recovery from infection.

Mechanism of Action:

Aztreonam is a monobactam beta-lactam antibiotic that inhibits bacterial cell wall synthesis by binding to penicillin-binding proteins (PBPs).

This leads to weakening of the bacterial cell wall, causing cell lysis and death.

It is highly effective against aerobic Gram-negative bacteria and resistant to many betalactamases.

Dosage & Administration:

The dosage and route of administration depend on the type and severity of infection.

Administer by intramuscular (IM) or intravenous (IV) injection as directed by the physician.

Typical adult dose: 1–2 g every 8–12 hours, adjusted based on renal function and infection severity.

Reconstitute the vial with sterile water for injection or compatible IV fluids before use.

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to aztreonam or any component of the formulation.

Caution in patients allergic to other beta-lactam antibiotics.

Warnings & Precautions:

Use with caution in patients with renal or hepatic impairment.

Monitor renal function during prolonged therapy.

Discontinue use if allergic reactions, severe diarrhea, or rash occur.

Not effective against Gram-positive bacteria or anaerobes.

Side Effects:

Common: Injection site pain, rash, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting.

Rare: Elevated liver enzymes, eosinophilia, thrombophlebitis, hypersensitivity reactions, or anaphylaxis.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place. Protect from light and moisture. Use immediately after reconstitution. Keep out of reach of children.

Packaging:

Aztrip 2 Injection is available in sterile glass vials containing 2 g of Aztreonam, with sterile water for injection as diluent (where applicable).
