Information For the User Aztreonam (250mg) Injection

Aztrip 250 Injection

Brand Name: Aztrip 250 Injection

Composition:

Each vial contains Aztreonam IP 250 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated for the treatment of serious infections caused by susceptible Gram-negative bacteria including lower respiratory tract infections, urinary tract infections, skin and soft tissue infections, and septicemia

Also used in patients with cystic fibrosis for *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* infections Helps control bacterial growth and reduce infection-related complications

Mechanism of Action:

Aztreonam is a monobactam beta-lactam antibiotic

It inhibits bacterial cell wall synthesis by binding to penicillin-binding proteins, leading to cell lysis and death

Highly selective for aerobic Gram-negative bacteria and resistant to many beta-lactamases

Dosage & Administration:

Usual adult dose: 500 mg to 2 g every $8 \text{ to } 12 \text{ hours depending on infection severity and renal function, or as directed by the physician$

For Aztrip 250 mg, dose adjustment may be required in renal impairment

Administer via intravenous infusion over 30 minutes or intramuscular injection as advised Ensure reconstitution with suitable diluent according to guidelines

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Aztreonam or any beta-lactam antibiotic

History of severe hypersensitivity reactions to any cephalosporin or penicillin should be used with caution

Warnings & Precautions:

Monitor renal function in patients with impaired kidney function Use with caution in patients with a history of gastrointestinal disease, especially colitis Observe for signs of hypersensitivity reactions including rash, pruritus, or anaphylaxis Prolonged therapy may lead to superinfections with non-susceptible organisms

Side Effects:

Common: local injection site reactions, rash, nausea, diarrhea

Less common: headache, fever, elevated liver enzymes

Rare: anaphylaxis, neutropenia, thrombocytopenia, seizures in severe renal impairment

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C

Protect from light Keep out of reach of children

Packaging:

Aztrip 250 Injection is available in sterile vials for intravenous or intramuscular use

Schedule H Prescription Drug – To be sold by retail on the prescription of a registered medical practitioner only
