Description:

Beniflip 4 Tablet contains **Benidipine**, a **long-acting calcium channel blocker** (**CCB**) belonging to the **dihydropyridine class**. It helps in **lowering blood pressure** by **relaxing blood vessels**, improving blood flow, and reducing the **workload on the heart**.
