Each film-coated tablet contains:

- **Bupropion Hydrochloride IP 150 mg**
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Description:

Bupimax 150 Tablet contains **Bupropion**, an atypical antidepressant that acts as a **norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRI)**. It helps in improving mood, motivation, and overall mental well-being. It is also used to support treatment in nicotine dependence by reducing cravings and withdrawal symptoms.

Indications:

Indicated for:

- Major Depressive Disorder (MDD)
- Smoking cessation support

It helps in **improving depressive symptoms and reducing nicotine withdrawal effects**.

Dosage & Administration:

Dose should be individualized as directed by the physician.

Tablets should be swallowed whole and **not crushed, chewed, or split**.

Pharmacological Action:

Bupropion blocks norepinephrine and dopamine reuptake in the CNS, increasing neurotransmitter availability and improving mood regulation and motivation.

Side Effects:

Generally well tolerated. Mild headache, dry mouth, or difficulty sleeping may occur in some patients.

Warnings & Precautions:

- Use with caution in patients with seizure risk or severe hepatic impairment.
 - Avoid excessive alcohol consumption.
 - Monitor mood and psychological response during therapy.
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Drug Interactions:

May interact with MAO inhibitors, antiepileptic drugs, and alcohol. Use only under medical supervision when given with other CNS-active medications.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place. Protect from moisture and direct light.
Keep out of reach of children.
