# Information For the User Cilnidipine 20 mg tablet

# Cildraw 20 Tablet

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### Composition

Each film-coated tablet contains:

• Cilnidipine IP ... 20 mg Excipients ... q.s.

#### **Dosage Form**

Tablet (oral administration).

### **Therapeutic Category**

Antihypertensive – Calcium Channel Blocker (L/N-type).

#### **Indications**

Cildraw 20 Tablet is indicated for:

- Management of essential hypertension
- Reduction of blood pressure in patients at risk of cardiovascular complications
- May be used as monotherapy or in combination with other antihypertensive agents

It works by blocking calcium influx through L- and N-type calcium channels, resulting in vasodilation and reduced blood pressure.

#### **Dosage & Administration**

- Adults: 20 mg once daily, orally, with or without food.
- Dose may be adjusted based on patient response and physician guidance.
- Administer at the same time each day for optimal effect.

#### **Contraindications**

- Hypersensitivity to Cilnidipine or any excipients
- Severe hypotension
- Cardiogenic shock
- Pregnancy and lactation unless prescribed

#### **Warnings & Precautions**

- Use with caution in patients with severe hepatic impairment or heart failure
- Monitor blood pressure and heart rate periodically
- Discontinue if signs of hypotension or severe adverse effects occur

#### **Adverse Effects**

Common: Dizziness, headache, flushing, palpitations, edema.

Rare: Gastrointestinal disturbances, rash, hypersensitivity reactions.

## **Drug Interactions**

May interact with other antihypertensives, CYP3A4 inhibitors/inducers, and grapefruit juice (may increase plasma concentration).

### **Storage**

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C. Protect from light and moisture. Keep out of reach of children.
