Description:

Colchirate 0.5 Tablet contains **Colchicine**, an anti-inflammatory agent used primarily in the management of gout and familial Mediterranean fever. It helps in **reducing inflammation, pain, and swelling associated with acute gout attacks.**

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated for:

- Acute gout attacks
- Prophylaxis of recurrent gout flares
- Familial Mediterranean fever

It helps in controlling inflammation and preventing recurrence of attacks.

Dosage & Administration:

Take as directed by the physician.

Swallow the tablet whole with water, preferably after meals to minimize gastrointestinal discomfort.

Pharmacological Action:

Colchicine inhibits microtubule polymerization, which interferes with neutrophil activity and reduces the inflammatory response. This leads to decreased swelling, pain, and redness during gout attacks.

Side Effects:

Mild gastrointestinal disturbances such as nausea, abdominal discomfort, or diarrhea may occur in some patients.

Warnings & Precautions:

- Use with caution in patients with renal or hepatic impairment.
- Avoid use during pregnancy unless clearly indicated.
- Monitor blood counts during prolonged therapy.
- Discontinue if severe gastrointestinal symptoms occur.

Drug Interactions:

May interact with drugs such as cyclosporine, macrolide antibiotics, and certain antifungals. Inform your physician about all concurrent medications.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place. Protect from light and moisture. Keep out of reach of children.
