Composition:

Each metered dose contains:

• Beclomethasone Dipropionate IP – 50 mcg

• Levosalbutamol Sulphate IP equivalent to Levosalbutamol – 50 mcg

• Propellant and Excipients -q.s.

Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Critsal B Inhaler is a dual-action respiratory therapy combining an inhaled corticosteroid and a short-acting bronchodilator.

- **Beclomethasone Dipropionate** is a potent anti-inflammatory corticosteroid that reduces airway inflammation, edema, and hyperresponsiveness.
- **Levosalbutamol** is a selective β 2-adrenergic receptor agonist that causes relaxation of bronchial smooth muscle, providing quick relief from bronchospasm.

This combination offers both maintenance and immediate symptom control in obstructive airway diseases.

Indications:

- Asthma mild to moderate persistent asthma
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Exercise-induced bronchospasm
- Allergic bronchitis and seasonal airway inflammation

Dosage & Administration:

- Adults and adolescents: 1 to 2 inhalations, twice daily or as directed by a physician
- Shake well before each use
- Rinse mouth after use to prevent oral candidiasis

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to any of the ingredients
- Acute episodes of severe asthma requiring intensive management
- Use with caution in patients with cardiac arrhythmias or hypertension

Warnings & Precautions:

- Long-term use may cause adrenal suppression; monitor regularly
- Not for relief of acute asthma attacks
- Caution in pediatric patients; use lowest effective dose
- Regular monitoring of pulmonary function and symptom control advised

Adverse Effects:

• Common: Throat irritation, hoarseness, cough

- Occasional: Headache, palpitations, tremors
- Rare: Oral thrush, hypersensitivity reactions, paradoxical bronchospasm

Overdose:

- Overuse of Levosalbutamol may lead to hypokalemia, tachycardia, or tremors
- Excess corticosteroid may cause systemic effects
- Supportive treatment and discontinuation advised in case of overdose

Storage:

Store below 30°C Do not puncture or incinerate the canister Protect from sunlight and moisture Keep out of reach of children
