Composition: Each 5 ml of syrup contains:

- **Ambroxol** 15 mg
- **Guaifenesin** -50 mg
- **Levocetirizine** 2.5 mg
- Menthol 1 mg

Pharmacological Actions:

- 1. **Ambroxol**: An expectorant and mucolytic agent, Ambroxol works by breaking down mucus, making it less viscous and easier to expel. It stimulates the production of surfactant, which improves the function of the respiratory system.
- 2. **Guaifenesin**: An expectorant that helps loosen up mucus in the airways, making it easier to clear the chest of mucus. It increases the volume and reduces the viscosity of respiratory tract secretions.
