Description:

Ambroxol 7.5mg + Levosalbutamol 0.25mg + Guaifenesin 12.5mg Drop is a combination medication used to treat respiratory conditions that involve excessive mucus production, coughing, and bronchospasm. It is commonly used in conditions like acute or chronic bronchitis, asthma, and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). The combination of Ambroxol, Levosalbutamol, and Guaifenesin helps to:

- Reduce bronchospasm (Levosalbutamol),
- Loosen mucus and make it easier to expel (Ambroxol and Guaifenesin),
- Enhance airway clearance and improve breathing.

Composition:

Each 1 ml of the drop contains:

• Ambroxol: 7.5 mg

• Levosalbutamol: 0.25 mg

• Guaifenesin: 12.5 mg

Indications:

This combination drop is used for the treatment of:

- Acute and chronic respiratory conditions such as bronchitis, asthma, and COPD.

Mechanism of Action:

- Ambroxol:

Drug Interactions:

- Beta-blockers (e.g., propranolol):
 - May reduce the effectiveness of Levosalbutamol and cause bronchospasm.
- Other bronchodilators or decongestants:
 - Should be used with caution to avoid overlapping effects or increased heart rate.
- Cough suppressants:

 Concurrent use with cough suppressants may reduce the effectiveness of Ambroxol and Guaifenesin in loosening mucus.

Storage Instructions:

- Store at room temperature (15°C to 30°C).
- Keep the bottle tightly closed when not in use.
- · Keep out of reach of children.
- Shake well before use.

Note:

Always use Ambroxol + Levosalbutamol + Guaifenesin Drops as directed by your healthcare provider. It is essential to follow the prescribed dosage and not exceed the recommended amount. If symptoms persist or worsen, consult your doctor for further evaluation and possible adjustments to your treatment plan.
