Composition:

Each 5 ml contains:

- Dextromethorphan Hydrobromide IP 5 mg
- Chlorpheniramine Maleate IP 2 mg
- · Excipients q.s.
- Flavoured syrupy base q.s.
- · Colour: Approved Colour used

Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Dextromethorphan is a centrally acting antitussive that suppresses the cough reflex by acting on the medullary cough center without causing respiratory depression or dependency.

Chlorpheniramine Maleate is a first-generation antihistamine (H1 receptor antagonist) that inhibits histamine action, reducing allergic symptoms like sneezing, rhinorrhea, and nasal congestion.

The combination provides relief from dry, irritating, non-productive cough and associated allergic manifestations.

Indications:

- · Dry and non-productive cough
- Allergic cough associated with rhinitis or cold
- · Post-nasal drip with throat irritation
- · Night-time cough relief

Dosage & Administration:

- · Adults: 5 ml every 4 to 6 hours as directed by the physician
- Children (6–12 years): 2.5 ml every 4 to 6 hours
- Maximum 4 doses per day
- Shake well before use

Contraindications:

- · Hypersensitivity to Dextromethorphan, Chlorpheniramine, or any excipient
- Concurrent use with monoamine oxidase inhibitors (MAOIs) or within 14 days of stopping them
- Severe cardiovascular disorders or severe hypertension

Warnings & Precautions:

- May cause drowsiness; caution while driving or operating machinery
- · Use with caution in patients with asthma, COPD, or chronic respiratory conditions
- · Avoid alcohol or other CNS depressants

- Not recommended in children under 6 years without medical supervision
- · Use during pregnancy and lactation only if clearly needed

Drug Interactions:

- MAO inhibitors risk of serotonin syndrome with Dextromethorphan
- CNS depressants and alcohol enhanced sedation
- · Anticholinergic drugs additive anticholinergic effects with Chlorpheniramine

Adverse Effects:

- · Common: Drowsiness, dizziness, dry mouth, nausea
- · Rare: Nervousness, restlessness, urinary retention, blurred vision

Storage:

- Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place
- · Protect from sunlight and moisture
- · Keep out of reach of children
