Composition:

Each sustained-release tablet contains:

- Diltiazem Hydrochloride IP 60 mg
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Description:

Diltriz SR 60 Tablet contains Diltiazem, a calcium channel blocker indicated for the management of cardiovascular conditions such as hypertension and angina pectoris. The sustained-release formulation provides prolonged therapeutic action and improved symptom control. It helps in reducing cardiac workload, improving coronary blood flow, and controlling blood pressure.

Indications:

Indicated for the treatment of:

- Hypertension
- Chronic stable angina
- Vasospastic angina
- Certain supraventricular arrhythmias

It helps in controlling blood pressure, reducing anginal attacks, and improving cardiovascular function.

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be as directed by the physician.

The tablet should be swallowed whole with water and should not be crushed or chewed.

It may be taken with or without food at the same time each day.

Pharmacological Action:

- **Diltiazem** inhibits the influx of calcium ions across cardiac and vascular smooth muscle cells.
- It causes coronary and peripheral vasodilation, reducing myocardial oxygen demand.
- It also slows atrioventricular conduction and decreases heart rate in certain arrhythmias.

These actions help in improving cardiac efficiency and controlling cardiovascular symptoms.

Side Effects:

Common side effects include headache, dizziness, flushing, edema, nausea, and bradycardia. Rarely, hypotension, conduction disturbances, or hypersensitivity reactions may occur.

Precautions & Warnings:

- Use with caution in patients with heart failure, hepatic impairment, or conduction abnormalities
 - Monitor blood pressure and heart rate regularly
 - Avoid abrupt discontinuation without medical advice
 - Use cautiously in elderly patients
 - Pregnancy and lactation use should be based on physician assessment
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Drug Interactions:

May interact with beta-blockers, digoxin, antihypertensives, and CYP3A4 inhibitors. Concurrent use with other cardiac depressants may increase the risk of bradycardia or hypotension.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place.
Protect from light and moisture.
Keep out of reach of children.
