# Enapal 5 Tablet

**Brand Name:** Enapal 5 Tablet

**Composition:**

Each uncoated tablet contains:

Enalapril Maleate IP equivalent to Enalapril 5 mg

**Therapeutic Indication:**

Used in the management of hypertension

Indicated for treatment of congestive heart failure

Helps in prevention of symptomatic heart failure in asymptomatic left ventricular dysfunction

Also indicated in diabetic nephropathy

**Mechanism of Action:**

Enalapril is an ACE (Angiotensin-Converting Enzyme) inhibitor

It blocks the conversion of angiotensin I to angiotensin II

This results in vasodilation, decreased blood pressure, and reduced cardiac workload

**Dosage & Administration:**

Usual adult dose: 2.5 mg to 20 mg once or twice daily, as per physician's advice

Dose adjustment may be needed in renal impairment

To be taken as directed by the physician

**Contraindications:**

Hypersensitivity to Enalapril or any ACE inhibitors

History of angioedema

Pregnancy and lactation

Bilateral renal artery stenosis

**Warnings & Precautions:**

Monitor serum potassium and renal function regularly

Use with caution in patients with renal impairment or volume depletion

Discontinue if persistent cough or angioedema occurs

Not recommended during pregnancy (Category D)

**Side Effects:**

Common: dizziness, headache, dry cough, fatigue, hyperkalemia, hypotension

Rare but serious: angioedema, renal dysfunction

**Storage:**

Store in a cool, dry, and dark place below 25°C

Keep out of reach of children

**Packaging:**

Enapal 5 Tablet is available in alu-alu/blister strips

**Schedule:**

Schedule H Prescription Drug – Not to be sold without the prescription of a registered medical practitioner
