Composition:

Each film coated tablet contains:
Fenofibrate I.P. 200 mg

Description:

Fenoflick 200 Tablet contains Fenofibrate, a lipid-lowering agent used to manage abnormal levels of cholesterol and triglycerides in the blood. It works by enhancing the breakdown and elimination of triglyceride-rich particles and improving the balance of lipids. This helps reduce the risk of cardiovascular diseases and supports overall heart health.

Indications:

Hypertriglyceridemia
Mixed dyslipidemia
Hypercholesterolemia (adjunct therapy)
Prevention of cardiovascular complications

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be taken as directed by the physician.
Tablet should be taken with meals for better absorption.

Pharmacological Action:

Fenofibrate activates peroxisome proliferator-activated receptor alpha (PPAR- α), which increases lipolysis and elimination of triglyceride-rich lipoproteins. It reduces triglycerides, lowers LDL cholesterol, and increases HDL cholesterol levels.

Side Effects:

Nausea
Abdominal pain
Headache
Elevated liver enzymes
Muscle pain (rare)

Precautions & Warnings:

Use under medical supervision only.
Regular monitoring of liver function and lipid profile is recommended.
Use cautiously in patients with liver or renal impairment.
Avoid use in patients with gallbladder disease unless prescribed.

Drug Interactions:

May interact with statins, anticoagulants, and other lipid-lowering agents.
Consult physician before using with other medications.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a dry place.
Protect from light and moisture.
Keep out of reach of children.
