Ferric Carboxymaltose (500mg) Injection

- Treating Iron Deficiency Anemia When oral iron is ineffective or poorly tolerated.
- To manage anemia during and after pregnancy.
- To address iron deficiency caused by excessive menstrual bleeding.
- To treat anemia associated with conditions like uterine fibroids.
- It is an intravenous iron replacement therapy used to treat iron deficiency anemia when oral iron supplements are effective or cannot be used.
- Treats Anemia where you have fewer amount of red blood cells due to insufficient iron in your body (iron-deficiency anemia).
- A form of iron that can be given as an injection directly into the bloodstream, making it a useful option for patients who have difficulty absorbing iron from the gastrointestinal tract.
