Fexoform 120 Tablet

Composition: Each tablet contains:

• Fexofenadine Hydrochloride: 120 mg

Indications:

Fexoform 120 is used to treat symptoms associated with allergic conditions, including:

- Seasonal Allergic Rhinitis (Hay Fever): Provides relief from symptoms such as sneezing, runny nose, itchy or watery eyes, and throat irritation caused by allergies to pollen.
- Chronic Idiopathic Urticaria (Chronic Hives): Helps relieve symptoms of hives, including red, itchy skin rashes and swelling, which can occur without any known cause.

Mechanism of Action:

Fexoform (fexofenadine) is a second-generation antihistamine that selectively blocks H1 receptors in the body. Histamine is a substance released during allergic reactions, which causes symptoms like itching, sneezing, and swelling. By blocking histamine, fexofenadine prevents or reduces these allergic symptoms without causing significant sedation.

Dosage and Administration:

• Adults and Children 12 years and older: Take one tablet (120 mg) once daily, preferably with water. It may be taken with or without food. • Children under 12 years: The use of Fexoform 120 is not recommended for children under the age of 12.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity: Fexoform should not be used by individuals who are allergic to fexofenadine or any of the ingredients in the tablet.
- Severe Renal Impairment: Use with caution in patients with severe kidney problems, as it may require dose adjustment.

Precautions:

- Pregnancy and Breastfeeding: Consult your doctor if you are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding. The safety of fexofenadine during pregnancy and lactation is not fully established.
- Kidney Function: Fexoform should be used with caution in individuals with kidney problems. Dose adjustments may be necessary.
- Alcohol: Although fexofenadine is a nonsedating antihistamine, it is advised to avoid alcohol while taking this medication, as it may increase the likelihood of side effects like dizziness or drowsiness.

Possible Side Effects: Common side effects include:

- Headache
- Drowsiness (although less common than older antihistamines)
- Dry mouth
- Dizziness
- Nausea

Serious but rare side effects include:

- Allergic reactions: Such as rash, itching, swelling of the face, lips, or throat, and difficulty breathing.
- Severe dizziness: Which may indicate a more serious condition.

Drug Interactions:

- Antacids: Antacids containing aluminum or magnesium can reduce the absorption of fexofenadine. It is recommended to take Fexoform 120 at least 2 hours before or after using such antacids.
- Erythromycin and Ketoconazole: These drugs can increase the blood levels of fexofenadine, potentially increasing the risk of side effects.
- Other antihistamines: Caution should be exercised if using other antihistamines concurrently, as this may increase the risk of side effects such as sedation and dry mouth.

Storage:

Store the tablet at room temperature $(15^{\circ}C-30^{\circ}C)$, away from direct sunlight, heat, and moisture. Keep the medication out of reach of children.
