Cefpodoxime Proxetil (200mg) + Ofloxacin (200mg) Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

- Cefpodoxime Proxetil: 200 mg
- Ofloxacin: 200 mg

Pharmacological Class:

- Cefpodoxime Proxetil: Third-generation cephalosporin antibiotic.
- Ofloxacin: Fluoroquinolone antibiotic.

Indications:

This combination is used to treat a variety of bacterial infections, particularly mixed infections caused by susceptible organisms. Common indications include:

- Respiratory Tract Infections: Acute bronchitis, community-acquired pneumonia.
- Urinary Tract Infections (UTI): Complicated and uncomplicated infections.
- Skin and Soft Tissue Infections: Cellulitis, abscesses, wound infections.
- Gastrointestinal Infections: Typhoid fever, enteric fever.

Mechanism of Action:

- Swallow the tablet whole with water; do not crush or chew.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to cefpodoxime, ofloxacin, cephalosporins, fluoroquinolones, or any excipients in the tablet.
- History of tendon disorders related to fluoroquinolone use.
- Severe renal or hepatic impairment (dose adjustments may be necessary).
- Epilepsy or seizure disorders.

Warnings and Precautions:

- Allergic Reactions: Monitor for rash, swelling, or anaphylaxis. Discontinue if these occur.
- Tendinitis and Tendon Rupture: Associated with fluoroquinolone use, especially in elderly patients or those on corticosteroids.
- Clostridium difficile-Associated Diarrhea (CDAD): May occur during or after treatment.
- Photosensitivity: Avoid excessive sunlight or UV light exposure during treatment.
- QT Prolongation: Use cautiously in patients with heart conditions or electrolyte imbalances.
- Renal and Hepatic Impairment: Monitor function and adjust dose if necessary.

Side Effects:

- Common Side Effects:

 - Diarrhea
 - Abdominal pain
 - Headache

- Dizziness
- Serious Side Effects:
 - Severe allergic reactions (anaphylaxis)
 - Tendon rupture
 - Pseudomembranous colitis
 - Seizures

Drug Interactions:

- Antacids and Iron Supplements: Reduce ofloxacin absorption; take at least 2 hours apart.
- Probenecid: Increases cefpodoxime levels by reducing renal excretion.
- Antiarrhythmic Drugs: May increase the risk of QT prolongation when used with ofloxacin.

Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C, away from light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.
