# Fluprime Eye Drop

**Brand Name:** Fluprime Eye Drop

**Dosage Form:** Eye Drops

**Composition:**

Each ml contains:

- Flurbiprofen Sodium IP 0.03% w/v
- Benzalkonium Chloride Solution IP 0.001% v/v (as preservative)
- Sterile ophthalmic vehicle q.s.

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**Description:**

Fluprime Eye Drop contains Flurbiprofen Sodium, a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) used in ophthalmic practice for the prevention and treatment of ocular inflammation. It helps in reducing inflammation, pain, and discomfort associated with various eye conditions and ophthalmic surgical procedures. The formulation provides localized anti-inflammatory action within ocular tissues.

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**Indications:**

Indicated for the treatment and prevention of:

- Post-operative ocular inflammation
- Ocular pain and discomfort
- Inhibition of intraoperative miosis during cataract surgery
- Inflammatory conditions of the anterior segment of the eye

It helps in reducing ocular inflammation, pain, redness, and associated symptoms.

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**Dosage & Administration:**

Instill the prescribed number of drops into the affected eye(s) as directed by the physician.

Wash hands thoroughly before administration.

Avoid touching the dropper tip to any surface to prevent contamination.

If using other ophthalmic medications, maintain an interval of at least 5–10 minutes between applications.

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**Pharmacological Action:**

- Flurbiprofen Sodium inhibits cyclooxygenase (COX) enzymes, thereby reducing the synthesis of prostaglandins responsible for ocular inflammation and pain.
- It also helps prevent intraoperative miosis by inhibiting prostaglandin-mediated constriction of the pupil.

These actions help in controlling inflammation and improving patient comfort.

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**Side Effects:**

Common side effects include transient burning or stinging sensation, eye irritation, blurred vision, redness, and discomfort after instillation.

Rarely, hypersensitivity reactions or corneal complications may occur with prolonged use.

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**Precautions & Warnings:**

- For ophthalmic use only
- Use with caution in patients with known hypersensitivity to NSAIDs
- Prolonged use may delay corneal healing in susceptible individuals
- Remove contact lenses before administration and reinsert as advised by the physician
- Avoid contamination of the dropper tip

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**Drug Interactions:**

May be used with other ophthalmic medications under medical supervision.

If used concomitantly with topical corticosteroids, caution is advised as wound healing may be delayed.

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**Storage:**

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place.

Protect from light.

Do not freeze.

Keep the bottle tightly closed after use.

Keep out of reach of children.
