Fluticasone Propionate 250mcg + Formoterol Fumarate 6mcg

Form:

Inhalation Capsule (to be used with a compatible inhalation device)

Therapeutic Class:

Combination of Corticosteroid and Long-Acting Beta-2 Agonist (LABA)

Description

This combination medication contains:

- Fluticasone Propionate: A potent inhaled corticosteroid that reduces airway inflammation, thereby preventing and controlling asthma symptoms.
- Formoterol Fumarate: A long-acting beta-2 agonist that relaxes bronchial smooth muscles, providing long-term relief from bronchospasm and improving breathing.

The combination provides effective control for moderate to severe asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

- Asthma: Maintenance treatment in patients requiring both an inhaled corticosteroid and a long-acting beta-2 agonist.
- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD): Management of airflow obstruction and reduction of exacerbations.

Dosage and Administration

- Adults and Adolescents (12 years and older):
 - One capsule inhaled twice daily (morning and evening).
- Maximum Dose: As prescribed by the healthcare provider.

Instructions for Use:

- 1. Insert the capsule into the inhalation device as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- 2. Breathe out fully, then inhale deeply through the device to ensure proper delivery of the medication.
- 3. Hold your breath for 5-10 seconds, then exhale slowly.
- 4. Discard the used capsule immediately after use.

Note: Do not swallow the capsule; it is intended for inhalation only.

Contraindications

Hypersensitivity to fluticasone, formoterol, or any excipients in the formulation.

Indications

- Acute asthma attacks or acute COPD exacerbations (not intended for rescue therapy).
- Beta-blockers may reduce the efficacy of formoterol.
- Use with other sympathomimetic drugs may increase cardiovascular side effects.

Precautions

- Asthma Management: Should not be initiated in patients during an acute asthma exacerbation.
- Paradoxical Bronchospasm: Discontinue immediately if it occurs.
- Systemic Corticosteroid Effects: Prolonged use may lead to adrenal suppression or growth retardation in children.
- Cardiovascular Conditions: Use cautiously in patients with hypertension, arrhythmias, or heart disease due to the beta-agonist component.
- Infections: Monitor for oral thrush; rinse mouth and throat after each use.

Side Effects

Common side effects:

- Hoarseness or sore throat
- Oral candidiasis (thrush)
- Headache
- Tremors or palpitations

Rare but serious side effects:

- Paradoxical bronchospasm
- Increased heart rate or blood pressure
- Hypokalemia
- Vision changes (e.g., cataracts or glaucoma)

Storage Instructions

- Store at a temperature below 25°C.
- Protect from moisture and light.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Additional Notes

- This medication is intended for regular, long-term use and not for immediate relief of acute symptoms. Use a shortacting bronchodilator for rescue therapy.
- Monitor asthma or COPD control periodically and adjust dosage as needed.
- Seek medical attention if symptoms worsen or if side effects occur.
