Generic Name: Fluticasone Furoate

Strength: 50mcg per spray

Form: Nasal Spray

Therapeutic Class: Corticosteroid

Description

Fluticasone Furoate is a synthetic corticosteroid with potent antiinflammatory properties. It acts locally in the nasal passages to reduce inflammation and relieve symptoms of allergic rhinitis and other nasal conditions.

Indications

Fluticasone Furoate 50mcg Nasal Spray is indicated for:

- Allergic Rhinitis: Seasonal and perennial (in adults and children aged 2 years and older).
- Nasal Polyps: Symptom relief and reduction in polyp size.
- Non-Allergic Rhinitis: Management of nasal inflammation and congestion.

Dosage and Administration

- Adults and Adolescents (12 years and older):
 - Initial dose: Two sprays (50mcg each) in each nostril once daily (total 200mcg).
 - Maintenance dose: One spray in each nostril daily (total 100mcg).
- Children (2 to 11 years):
 - One spray in each nostril once daily (total 100mcg).

How to Use:

- 1. Shake the bottle gently before use.
- 2. Prime the spray by pressing down several times until a fine mist appears (only for first use or if unused for a week or more).
- **3.** Insert the nozzle into one nostril while closing the other.
- 4. Spray while gently inhaling through the nose. Repeat for the other nostril.

Contraindications

- Hypersensitivity to fluticasone or any excipients in the formulation.
- Untreated localized infections involving the nasal mucosa, such as herpes simplex.

Precautions

• Systemic Corticosteroid Effects: Although rare, prolonged use may lead to systemic effects such as adrenal suppression or delayed wound healing.

- Nasal Issues: Use cautiously in patients with recent nasal surgery, trauma, or ulcers.
- Infections: Monitor for signs of infections such as candidiasis in the nasal passages.
- Growth Monitoring: Regular monitoring of growth in pediatric patients is recommended with longterm use.

Side Effects

Common side effects:

- Nasal irritation or dryness
- Sneezing
- Headache
- Nosebleeds (epistaxis)

Rare but serious side effects:

- Nasal septum perforation
- Vision changes (e.g., cataracts, glaucoma)
- Hypersensitivity reactions (e.g., rash, angioedema)

Drug Interactions

- Concomitant use with strong CYP3A4 inhibitors (e.g., ketoconazole, ritonavir) may increase systemic corticosteroid exposure.
- Avoid using other nasal corticosteroids unless prescribed.

Storage Instructions

• Store at a temperature below 30°C.

- Protect from direct sunlight and do not freeze.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Additional Notes

- Fluticasone Furoate nasal spray provides relief after a few days of consistent use; it is not intended for immediate symptom relief.
- Do not exceed the recommended dose.
- Seek medical advice if symptoms persist or worsen after a few days of use.
