Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

- **Gabapentin 300 mg**

Description:

Gabaxuro 300 Tablet contains Gabapentin, an anticonvulsant and neuropathic pain modulator. It helps in stabilizing abnormal electrical activity in the brain and modulating neurotransmission in the nervous system. **It helps in controlling partial seizures and alleviating neuropathic pain**, including burning, tingling, or shooting sensations.

Indications:

Indicated for:

- Epilepsy – partial seizures with or without secondary generalization
- Neuropathic pain

It helps in **reducing seizure frequency and managing nerve-related pain** when conventional therapy is insufficient.

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be individualized as directed by the physician.

Swallow the tablet whole with water. Can be taken with or without food.

Dose adjustment may be required in patients with renal impairment.

Pharmacological Action:

Gabapentin binds to the $\alpha 2\delta$ subunit of voltage-gated calcium channels in the central nervous system, reducing excitatory neurotransmitter release and stabilizing neuronal activity.

Side Effects:

Mild dizziness, drowsiness, or fatigue may occur in some patients.

Precautions & Warnings:

- Use with caution in patients with renal impairment
- Avoid abrupt discontinuation; taper gradually under medical supervision
- Monitor for mood changes or suicidal thoughts
- Avoid alcohol as it may enhance drowsiness

Drug Interactions:

May interact with antacids, CNS depressants, or other anticonvulsants.

Storage:

Store below **25°C** in a cool, dry place.

Protect from light and moisture.

Keep out of reach of children.
