Dosage Form: Eye Ointment

Composition:

Each gram contains:

- Ganciclovir IP 0.15% w/w (1.5 mg/g)
 - Ophthalmic ointment base q.s.

Description:

Ganivir Eye Ointment contains Ganciclovir, an antiviral agent indicated for the treatment of viral infections of the eye caused by susceptible herpes viruses. It is primarily used in the management of herpetic keratitis and related ocular viral infections. It helps in inhibiting viral replication, promoting healing of corneal lesions, and reducing the progression of infection.

Indications:

Indicated for the treatment of:

- Acute herpetic keratitis (dendritic ulcers)
- Ocular infections caused by susceptible herpes simplex viruses
- Viral corneal infections as determined by the physician

It helps in controlling viral replication, facilitating corneal healing, and reducing infection-related ocular symptoms.

Dosage & Administration:

Apply a small quantity of ointment inside the lower conjunctival sac of the affected eye(s) as directed by the physician.

Wash hands thoroughly before application.

Avoid touching the tube tip to the eye or any surface to prevent contamination.

Continue treatment for the duration prescribed by the physician.

Pharmacological Action:

- Ganciclovir is an antiviral agent that inhibits viral DNA synthesis by interfering with viral DNA polymerase activity.
- It suppresses replication of susceptible herpes viruses within infected ocular tissues.

These actions help in controlling viral infection and promoting recovery of the corneal surface.

Side Effects:

Common side effects include temporary blurred vision, eye irritation, burning sensation, redness, and foreign body sensation.

Rarely, hypersensitivity reactions or superficial punctate keratitis may occur.

Precautions & Warnings:

- For ophthalmic use only
 - Not effective against non-viral ocular infections
 - Avoid contamination of the tube tip
 - Contact lenses should not be worn during active ocular infection unless advised by the physician
 - Discontinue use and seek medical attention if severe irritation or allergic reaction occurs

Drug Interactions:

No significant systemic drug interactions are expected due to minimal systemic absorption.
If used with other ophthalmic medications, maintain an appropriate interval between applications.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place.

Protect from light.

Do not freeze.

Keep the tube tightly closed after use.

Keep out of reach of children.
