Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Glycopyrrolate is a long-acting anticholinergic agent that competitively inhibits muscarinic receptors in the airways. By blocking parasympathetic-mediated bronchoconstriction, it causes bronchodilation and reduces mucus secretion, improving airflow in patients with obstructive airway diseases.

Indications:

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Bronchial asthma (as adjunct therapy)
- Maintenance therapy for reversible airway obstruction

Dosage & Administration:

- Adults: 1 Rota Capsule twice daily or as directed by the physician
- Swallow whole with water; do not chew or crush
- Use regularly for optimal therapeutic effect

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Glycopyrrolate or any component of the formulation
- Patients with narrow-angle glaucoma or urinary retention

- Use with caution in patients with cardiac disorders, arrhythmias, or gastrointestinal obstruction

- Not recommended for pediatric patients unless prescribed by a physician
