Ivabradine 7.5 mg Tablet

Ivabriz 7.5 Tablet

Brand Name: Ivabriz 7.5 Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

Ivabradine Hydrochloride IP equivalent to Ivabradine 7.5 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Used in the treatment of chronic stable angina in patients with normal sinus rhythm who are intolerant to or inadequately controlled with beta-blockers

Indicated for chronic heart failure with reduced ejection fraction (HFrEF) in patients with sinus rhythm and resting heart rate ≥ 70 bpm, in combination with standard heart failure therapy

Mechanism of Action:

Ivabradine selectively inhibits the If (funny) current in the sinoatrial node

Reduces heart rate without affecting myocardial contractility or intracardiac conduction

Helps decrease myocardial oxygen demand and improves cardiac efficiency

Dosage & Administration:

Recommended starting dose is 5 mg twice daily

May be increased to 7.5 mg twice daily after evaluation of heart rate and tolerability

To be taken with meals or as directed by the physician

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Ivabradine or any excipients

Resting heart rate below 60 bpm before treatment

Acute decompensated heart failure

Severe hepatic impairment

Sick sinus syndrome, sinoatrial block, third-degree AV block

Pacemaker dependency

Concomitant use with strong CYP3A4 inhibitors (e.g., ketoconazole, clarithromycin)

Pregnancy and lactation

Warnings & Precautions:

Monitor heart rate and rhythm regularly

May cause transient visual symptoms such as phosphenes (brief increased brightness in vision)

Caution in patients with atrial fibrillation or conduction disturbances

Avoid grapefruit juice and CYP3A4 inhibitors during treatment

Side Effects:

Common: bradycardia, dizziness, fatigue, blurred vision, luminous phenomena

Less common: hypotension, atrial fibrillation, palpitations, headache

Rare: angioedema, allergic skin reactions

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry, and dark place below 25°C

Protect from moisture and direct sunlight
Keep out of reach of children

Packaging:

Ivabriz 7.5 Tablet is available in alu-alu or blister strip packs
