Levofloxacin (250mg) + Ornidazole (500mg)

Tablet: Information Guide

Description

This combination tablet contains Levofloxacin, a broad-spectrum antibiotic, and Ornidazole, an antiprotozoal and antibacterial agent. It is effective against a wide range of bacterial and protozoal infections, particularly mixed infections where both anaerobic bacteria and protozoa are involved.

Composition

- Levofloxacin: 250mg (a fluoroquinolone antibiotic).
- Ornidazole: 500mg (a nitroimidazole derivative with antiprotozoal and antibacterial properties).

Mechanism of Action

1. Levofloxacin:

- Inhibits bacterial DNA gyrase and topoisomerase IV, preventing bacterial DNA replication, transcription, and repair, leading to bacterial death.
- Effective against Gram-positive and Gram-negative bacteria.

2. Ornidazole:

- Disrupts DNA synthesis in anaerobic bacteria and protozoa, leading to cell death.
- Effective against anaerobes and protozoal infections like amoebiasis and giardiasis.

Indications

This tablet is indicated for the treatment of:

- Mixed bacterial and protozoal infections.
- Gastrointestinal infections such as amoebic dysentery and giardiasis.
- Pelvic inflammatory disease.
- Surgical site infections.
- Respiratory tract infections with suspected anaerobic involvement.
- Dental infections.

Dosage and Administration

- Recommended Dose: One tablet twice daily or as prescribed by a healthcare professional.

Contraindications

- Pregnancy and breastfeeding unless prescribed by a doctor.

Warnings and Precautions

- Avoid exposure to direct sunlight or UV light during treatment (risk of photosensitivity).
- Use cautiously in individuals with a history of tendon disorders or joint problems.
- Avoid alcohol consumption during treatment to prevent disulfiram-like reactions (nausea, vomiting, and flushing).
- Monitor for signs of superinfection or prolonged diarrhea, which could indicate Clostridioides difficile-associated colitis.

Adverse Effects

- Common: Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, headache, dizziness.
- Less Common: Rash, abdominal pain, metallic taste, or fatigue.
- Rare but Serious: Tendon rupture, peripheral neuropathy, QT prolongation, allergic reactions (seek medical attention if these occur).

Drug Interactions

- Avoid concurrent use with antacids, calcium, or iron supplements as they may reduce levofloxacin absorption.
- May interact with blood-thinning medications (e.g., warfarin) and enhance anticoagulant effects.
- Avoid simultaneous use with other neurotoxic drugs to reduce the risk of seizures.

Storage

 Store at a temperature below 25°C in a dry place. · Keep out of reach of children.

Key Points

- This tablet is effective for treating mixed infections involving bacteria and protozoa.
- Complete the full course of therapy as prescribed to prevent the development of resistance.
