Information For the User Losartan 50mg + Chlorthalidone 6.25mg Tablet

Composition:

Each uncoated tablet contains: Losartan Potassium IP 50 mg Chlorthalidone IP 6.25 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Used in the management of hypertension, including patients not adequately controlled with monotherapy

Helps reduce blood pressure and decrease the risk of stroke, myocardial infarction, and cardiovascular events

Combination therapy is indicated when a single antihypertensive is insufficient

Mechanism of Action:

Losartan is an angiotensin II receptor blocker (ARB) that selectively blocks AT1 receptors It causes vasodilation and decreases aldosterone secretion, reducing blood pressure Chlorthalidone is a thiazide-like diuretic that inhibits sodium and chloride reabsorption in distal renal tubules

The combination provides additive antihypertensive effect and better control of blood pressure

Dosage & Administration:

Usual adult dose: one tablet once daily or as directed by the physician

Can be taken with or without food

Dose adjustment may be required in renal or hepatic impairment

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Losartan, Chlorthalidone, or other sulfonamides Pregnancy and lactation

Severe renal impairment or anuria

Concomitant use with aliskiren in patients with diabetes or renal dysfunction

Warnings & Precautions:

Monitor blood pressure, renal function, and electrolytes regularly Caution in patients with volume depletion, heart failure, or renal artery stenosis May cause hypotension, hyperkalemia, or electrolyte imbalance Avoid excessive potassium intake or potassium supplements unless prescribed

Side Effects:

Common: dizziness, headache, fatigue, hypotension

Less common: hyperkalemia, nausea, cough, photosensitivity

Rare: angioedema, severe electrolyte disturbances, renal dysfunction

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry, and dark place below 25°C

Protect from moisture and sunlight Keep out of reach of children

Lorsan CH Tablet is available in blister or alu-alu strip packs
