Therapeutic Indication:

Lutyle XXL Cream is indicated for the **treatment of superficial fungal infections** of the skin, such as:

- Tinea corporis (ringworm of the body)
- Tinea cruris (jock itch)
- Tinea pedis (athlete's foot)
- Other dermatophytic infections

It helps in relieving itching, redness, scaling, and other symptoms caused by fungal infections.

Mechanism of Action:

- Luliconazole is an imidazole antifungal.
- It **inhibits the synthesis of ergosterol**, an essential component of fungal cell membranes.
- This results in disruption of the fungal cell membrane and death of the fungus.

Dosage & Administration:

- Apply a **thin layer of cream** to the affected area **once daily**, usually for **2–4 weeks** depending on the infection.
- Wash hands before and after application.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, and mucous membranes.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Luliconazole or other azole antifungals
- Open wounds or severe eczema at the application site

Warnings & Precautions:

- For external use only
- Avoid covering treated areas with airtight dressings unless directed by a physician

• Discontinue if severe irritation or allergic reaction occurs

Possible Side Effects:

- Mild burning, itching, or irritation at the application site
- Redness or dryness of the skin
- Rare: allergic reactions

Storage:

Store in a **cool**, **dry place below 25°C**, protected from light and moisture.
