# Information For the User Metoprolol Succinate (50mg) ER Metoperil XL 50

## **Composition**:

Each uncoated extended-release tablet contains:

- Metoprolol Succinate I.P. 50 mg (as extended release)
- **Excipients** q.s.

#### **Description**:

Metoperil XL 50 Tablet contains **Metoprolol Succinate**, a cardioselective  $\beta$ 1-adrenergic receptor blocker formulated in extended-release form for once-daily dosing. It helps in lowering blood pressure, managing angina, and improving survival after myocardial infarction.

## Indications:

- Hypertension
- Angina pectoris
- Heart failure (chronic, stable, symptomatic)
- Secondary prevention post-myocardial infarction

## **Pharmacological Action**:

Metoprolol acts selectively on  $\beta 1$  receptors, reducing cardiac output, heart rate, and myocardial contractility. It improves exercise tolerance and lowers myocardial oxygen demand without significant  $\beta 2$  (bronchial) receptor activity at therapeutic doses.

## **Dosage and Administration**:

As prescribed by the physician. Recommended once-daily oral dose in hypertension: 25–100 mg/day. Swallow whole; do not crush or chew.

## **Contraindications**:

- Known hypersensitivity to Metoprolol
- Severe bradycardia, heart block > first degree
- Decompensated heart failure
- Cardiogenic shock

## **Precautions and Warnings:**

- Caution in diabetes, asthma, and peripheral vascular diseases
- Gradual dose reduction required before discontinuation
- May mask symptoms of hypoglycemia

## Adverse Effects:

- Fatigue, dizziness
- Bradycardia, hypotension
- Gastrointestinal discomfort
- Cold extremities

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C. Protect from moisture and direct sunlight.
