Mometasone Furoate 0.1% Cream

Introduction

Mometasone Furoate 0.1% Cream is a **medium to high-potency corticosteroid** used for the treatment of inflammatory skin conditions such as **eczema**, **psoriasis**, **dermatitis**, **and allergic reactions**. It helps **reduce redness**, **swelling**, **itching**, **and discomfort** by suppressing the immune response and inflammation at the application site.

This cream is intended for **short-term use** and should be applied **under medical supervision**, especially for long-term conditions.

Pharmacological Properties

Mechanism of Action

Mometasone furoate is a **synthetic corticosteroid** with **anti-inflammatory**, **antipruritic**, **and vasoconstrictive properties**. It works by:

- Inhibiting the release of inflammatory mediators (prostaglandins, leukotrienes, and cytokines).
- Reducing capillary permeability, preventing fluid leakage and swelling.
- Suppressing immune cell activity in the skin, decreasing hypersensitivity reactions.

Due to its strong anti-inflammatory effect, it **rapidly alleviates symptoms** like redness, itching, and irritation in various skin disorders.

Indications & Uses

Mometasone 0.1% Cream is used to treat:

Dermatological Conditions:

- **Eczema (Atopic Dermatitis):** Reduces inflammation and itching in chronic eczema.
- **Psoriasis:** Helps control flare-ups by reducing scaling, redness, and thickened plaques.
- **Contact Dermatitis:** Treats skin irritation caused by allergens or irritants.
- **Seborrheic Dermatitis:** Controls scalp and facial inflammation associated with dandruff.
- **Lichen Planus:** Reduces swelling and discomfort caused by autoimmune skin inflammation.
- Pruritus (Itchy Skin): Helps in insect bites, allergic rashes, and localized itching.

Other Uses:

- Post-inflammatory Hyperpigmentation (PIH):
 Reduces redness and inflammation, preventing dark spots.
- **Insect Bite Reactions:** Relieves allergic swelling and irritation.

It is **not recommended for acne or fungal infections** unless prescribed in combination therapy.

Dosage & Administration

Application Guidelines:

- Dosage: Apply a thin layer once daily to the affected area.
- Method:
 - Clean and dry the skin before applying.
 - Gently rub in a small amount of cream without excessive rubbing.
 - Avoid occlusive dressings unless directed by a doctor.
- Duration: Use for a short period (usually 2 weeks) unless otherwise advised. Do not exceed 4 weeks without medical supervision.
- **Missed Dose:** Apply as soon as remembered, but **do not double the dose**.

Special Considerations:

- Do not apply on open wounds, broken skin, or infected areas unless instructed.
- Avoid use on the face, groin, or underarms unless prescribed, as these areas are more sensitive.
- Not for ophthalmic (eye) use—avoid contact with eyes.
- Tapering is required if used for prolonged periods to prevent rebound effects.

Drug Interactions

Potential Interactions:

- Other Topical Steroids: Concurrent use may increase systemic absorption and side effects.
- Immunosuppressants (Tacrolimus, Pimecrolimus): May increase immunosuppression and skin thinning.
- Antifungal or Antibacterial Creams: Avoid mixing unless prescribed in combination therapy.
- Oral Steroids (Prednisolone, Dexamethasone):
 May lead to systemic corticosteroid effects if used together.

Avoid Combining With:

- Strong Retinoids (Tretinoin, Isotretinoin): Can cause excessive skin irritation.
- Salicylic Acid or Benzoyl Peroxide (Acne Medications): May lead to excessive dryness and peeling.

Precautions & Warnings

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to corticosteroids: If allergic, avoid use.
- Bacterial, Viral, or Fungal Skin Infections: May worsen untreated infections.
- Rosacea & Perioral Dermatitis: Not recommended, as steroids can exacerbate these conditions.
- **Skin Atrophy Risk:** Long-term use can lead to **thinning of the skin**.

Use in Pregnancy & Lactation:

- Pregnancy: Use only if benefits outweigh risks (classified as Category C).
- Lactation: If breastfeeding, avoid applying on or near the breast area to prevent infant exposure.

Pediatric Use:

- Not recommended for children under 2 years.
- Use with caution in older children, as prolonged application may suppress adrenal function.

Side Effects

Mometasone 0.1% Cream is **well tolerated** when used correctly, but some side effects can occur.

Common Side Effects:

- Skin burning, stinging, or itching at the application site.
- **Dryness or peeling** of the skin.
- Redness or irritation in sensitive areas.

Rare but Serious Side Effects:

- **Skin Atrophy (Thinning of Skin):** Prolonged use can cause fragile, transparent skin.
- **Striae (Stretch Marks):** May appear on thin skin areas with prolonged use.
- Telangiectasia (Visible Blood Vessels): May develop with chronic steroid use.
- Systemic Absorption Effects:
 - Cushing's Syndrome: Moon face, weight gain, fatigue (if absorbed in large amounts).
 - Adrenal Suppression: Occurs with prolonged or high-dose application.

If any severe side effects occur, **discontinue use immediately** and consult a doctor.

Monitoring & Follow-Up

- Check for improvement within 2 weeks of use.
- Long-term users: Monitor for signs of skin thinning or atrophy.
- Children & elderly patients: Require regular assessment for potential side effects.

Storage & Handling

- Store at room temperature (below 25°C).
- Keep away from heat and direct sunlight.
- Do not freeze or expose to extreme temperatures.
- · Keep out of reach of children.
