Composition

• Moxifloxacin: 0.5% w/v

Description

Moxifloxacin ear drops contain a broadspectrum fluoroquinolone antibiotic that works by inhibiting bacterial DNA gyrase and topoisomerase IV. This action prevents bacterial replication, making it highly effective in treating infections caused by Gram-positive and Gramnegative bacteria.

Indications

- Acute otitis externa (infection of the external ear canal)
- Chronic suppurative otitis media (CSOM) with intact tympanic membrane
- Post-surgical prophylaxis or treatment of bacterial ear infections

Dosage and Administration

- Adults and Children: Instill 2-3 drops into the affected ear(s) twice daily or as directed by a healthcare provider.
- Tilt the head or lie down with the affected ear facing upward for a few minutes after application to ensure proper absorption.

Contraindications

• Hypersensitivity to Moxifloxacin or any fluoroquinolone antibiotics.

Precautions

• Avoid use if there is a suspected or confirmed perforation of the tympanic membrane unless advised by a healthcare professional.

- Use with caution in patients with a history of allergic reactions to fluoroquinolones.
- Discontinue use if signs of allergic reactions or worsening of symptoms occur.

Adverse Effects

- Temporary stinging, itching, or irritation in the ear.
- Rarely, allergic reactions such as rash, swelling, or redness may occur.

Storage

- Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place, protected from light.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Presentation

Available in a sterile dropper bottle of 5 mL or 10 mL.
