Description:

Adults: 1 capsule every 8–12 hours or as directed by the physician Administer after meals with a full glass of water Dose adjustment required in renal impairment

Side Effects:

Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea Skin rash, urticaria, allergic reactions Abdominal discomfort, bloating (mild) Rarely, pseudomembranous colitis

Precautions:

Check for penicillin hypersensitivity before prescribing
Use with caution in patients with renal or hepatic impairment
Prolonged use may result in superinfection with non-susceptible organisms
Avoid in patients with a history of severe antibiotic-associated colitis

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C Protect from light and moisture Keep out of reach of children
