Nebivolol 5 mg + Amlodipine 5 mg Tablet

Nebiroll A Tablet

Brand Name: Nebiroll A Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

Nebivolol Hydrochloride IP equivalent to Nebivolol 5 mg

Amlodipine Besylate IP equivalent to Amlodipine 5 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated for the treatment of essential hypertension

Recommended in patients who require combination therapy to achieve blood pressure goals

Also beneficial in hypertensive patients with coexisting cardiovascular risk factors like angina or tachycardia

Mechanism of Action:

Nebivolol is a cardioselective beta-1 blocker with vasodilatory action mediated via nitric oxide release

It reduces heart rate and cardiac output without compromising peripheral circulation

Amlodipine is a calcium channel blocker that inhibits calcium influx in vascular smooth muscle, leading to vasodilation and reduced peripheral resistance

Together they provide synergistic and complementary blood pressure-lowering effects

Dosage & Administration:

Usual adult dose: one tablet once daily or as directed by the physician

Can be taken with or without food

Swallow whole with water without crushing or chewing

Dose adjustments may be required based on clinical response and tolerability

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Amlodipine, Nebivolol, or any component of the formulation

Second or third-degree AV block, bradycardia, cardiogenic shock, or uncompensated heart failure

Severe hepatic impairment

Pregnancy and lactation

Warnings & Precautions:

Monitor blood pressure and heart rate regularly

Caution in patients with asthma, diabetes, hepatic or renal impairment, or peripheral vascular disease

Avoid abrupt withdrawal of beta-blocker component to prevent rebound hypertension

May cause dizziness or fatigue – caution while operating machinery or driving

Side Effects:

Common: headache, dizziness, fatigue, bradycardia, ankle edema

Less common: flushing, palpitations, sleep disturbances, gastrointestinal discomfort

Rare: allergic reactions, hypotension, AV block, worsening heart failure

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry, and dark place below 25°C
Protect from moisture and direct sunlight
Keep out of reach of children

Packaging:

Nebiroll A Tablet is available in blister or alu-alu strip packs

Schedule H Prescription Drug – To be sold by retail on the prescription of a registered medical practitioner only
