Information For the User Nicoumalone 2 mg Tablet

Nicotyle 2 tablet

Brand Name: Nicotyle 2 Tablet

Composition:

Each uncoated tablet contains:

Nicoumalone IP 2 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated for the prevention and treatment of thromboembolic disorders

Used in deep vein thrombosis (DVT), pulmonary embolism (PE), atrial fibrillation with risk of embolism, and in patients with prosthetic heart valves

Helps prevent stroke, systemic embolism, and recurrence of venous thrombosis

Mechanism of Action:

Nicoumalone is a vitamin K antagonist that inhibits the synthesis of clotting factors II, VII, IX, and X

By blocking these vitamin K-dependent clotting factors in the liver, it reduces the blood's ability to form clots

Provides effective long-term oral anticoagulation with INR-based dose adjustment

Dosage & Administration:

Initial dose and maintenance dose must be based on INR monitoring

Usual starting dose: 2 mg to 4 mg daily

Target INR: generally between 2.0 and 3.0 depending on clinical condition

Take the tablet at the same time each day, with or without food

Frequent INR monitoring is essential during treatment

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Nicoumalone or any excipient

Active bleeding or bleeding tendency

Severe hepatic or renal dysfunction

Pregnancy (Category X – teratogenic)

Recent or planned surgery involving high bleeding risk (CNS, eye, etc.)

Warnings & Precautions:

Frequent INR monitoring is necessary to maintain therapeutic range Avoid abrupt changes in diet, especially foods high in vitamin K (green leafy vegetables) Use caution with concurrent medications that affect coagulation or liver enzymes

Caution advised in elderly, fall-risk patients, and those with liver disease

Drug Interactions:

Significant interactions with antibiotics, antifungals, NSAIDs, antiplatelets, and certain anticonvulsants

Consult physician before starting or stopping any medicine

Monitor INR when changing medications

Side Effects:

Common: minor bleeding, bruising, nausea Less common: rash, elevated liver enzymes

Rare but serious: major bleeding, skin necrosis, purple toe syndrome

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry, and dark place below 25°C Protect from direct light and moisture Keep out of reach of children

Packaging:

Nicotyle 2 Tablet is available in blister or strip packs
