Composition

• Hydroxychloroquine Sulfate - 200mg

Mechanism of Action

Hydroxychloroquine alters immune system responses and interferes with inflammatory pathways. It also affects the metabolism of malarial parasites, preventing their growth and survival in red blood cells.

Indications

1. Autoimmune Disorders

- Rheumatoid Arthritis
- Systemic Lupus Erythematosus (SLE)
- Sjögren's Syndrome

2. Malaria Treatment and Prophylaxis

Effective against *Plasmodium* species responsible for malaria

3. Other Uses (As Prescribed by a Physician)

- Certain dermatological conditions
- Adjunct therapy in viral infections (under medical supervision)

Dosage & Administration

- As directed by a physician
- Typically taken once or twice daily with food to minimize stomach irritation
- Dosage depends on the patient's condition, weight, and medical history

Warnings & Precautions

Use with Caution in:

Patients with pre-existing retinal or visual disturbances

- Individuals with liver or kidney impairment
- Pregnant and breastfeeding women (only if prescribed by a doctor)

Avoid if:

- There is a known **allergy** to hydroxychloroquine or related compounds
- History of QT prolongation or heart rhythm disorders

Possible Side Effects

- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Headache, dizziness, or fatigue
- Skin rash or changes in skin pigmentation
- Retinal toxicity (rare but serious with prolonged use)

Note: Regular **eye examinations** are recommended for long-term users to monitor vision changes.

Storage Instructions

- Store in a cool, dry place below 30°C
- Keep away from direct sunlight and moisture
- Keep out of reach of children
