### Ranitidine Suspension (75mg/5ml)

**Active Ingredient:** Ranitidine Hydrochloride

**Strength:** 75mg per 5ml

#### *Uses:*

Ranitidine is an H<sub>2</sub>-receptor antagonist that reduces the production of stomach acid. It is commonly used for:

- Treating and preventing heartburn.
- Relieving symptoms of gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD).
- Treating stomach and duodenal ulcers.
- Conditions causing excessive stomach acid, such as Zollinger-Ellison syndrome.

#### *Dosage:*

- **Adults and children over 12 years:** Typically, 5–10ml (75–150mg) twice daily, or as prescribed by your doctor.
- **Children (3–11 years, depending on weight):** Doses are calculated based on body weight. Follow your doctor's guidance.

**Note:** Shake the bottle well before each use. Use the measuring device provided to ensure accurate dosing.

#### *Side Effects:*

Common side effects may include:

- Headache
- Constipation or diarrhea
- Nausea
- Dizziness

Rare but serious side effects:

- Allergic reactions (rash, swelling, or breathing difficulty)
- Yellowing of the skin or eyes (signs of liver issues)

#### *Precautions:*

- Do not use if you are allergic to ranitidine or any of its ingredients.
- Inform your doctor if you have kidney or liver disease.
- Not recommended for long-term use unless directed by your doctor.
- Avoid alcohol, as it may increase stomach acid and worsen symptoms.

#### *Storage:*

- Store at room temperature (20°C–25°C), away from direct light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.

#### *Warnings:*

The use of ranitidine has been limited or discontinued in many regions due to concerns over impurities (NDMA). Consult your healthcare provider for alternatives or further guidance.
