

Scotspas Suspension

Composition (per 5 ml):

- **Dicyclomine Hydrochloride I.P.** – 10 mg
- **Dimethicone I.P.** – 40 mg

Description:

Scotspas Suspension is a combination of an antispasmodic (Dicyclomine) and an anti-foaming agent (Dimethicone) used for the symptomatic relief of abdominal pain, bloating, and discomfort caused by gastrointestinal spasms and gas. Dicyclomine helps relax smooth muscles of the GI tract, while Dimethicone facilitates the dispersion of gas bubbles, relieving flatulence.

Indications:

- Infantile colic
- Abdominal bloating and gas
- Functional bowel disorders such as irritable bowel syndrome (IBS)
- Gastrointestinal spasms and cramps

Mechanism of Action:

Dicyclomine is an anticholinergic agent that exerts a direct smooth muscle relaxant effect on the GI tract, reducing spasms and cramping. Dimethicone is a surfactant that reduces surface tension of gas bubbles in the gut, aiding their coalescence and expulsion.

Dosage and Administration:

- **Infants and children:** 5 ml two to three times daily or as directed by the physician
- **Adults (if indicated):** Dosage as prescribed by the physician
- Shake well before use. Administer with a calibrated measuring device.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Dicyclomine or Dimethicone
- Glaucoma, urinary retention, or gastrointestinal obstruction (due to anticholinergic effect)
- Myasthenia gravis

Precautions:

- Use with caution in infants and very young children; dose adjustment required
- Monitor for anticholinergic side effects such as dry mouth or constipation
- Use in pregnancy and lactation only if clearly needed and prescribed

Side Effects:

- Mild drowsiness, dry mouth, nausea, constipation
- Rare: Allergic reactions, blurred vision, dizziness

Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C
- Protect from direct sunlight
- Keep out of reach of children
