Composition:

Each uncoated tablet contains:

- Dicyclomine Hydrochloride IP 20 mg
- Paracetamol IP 325 mg
- Excipients q.s.

Description:

Scotspas P Tablet is a synergistic combination of an anticholinergic agent and an analgesicantipyretic. Dicyclomine provides antispasmodic action by relaxing smooth muscles of the gastrointestinal tract, while Paracetamol relieves associated pain and fever. This dual-action makes Scotspas P effective in managing spasmodic abdominal pain of gastrointestinal, biliary, or genitourinary origin.

Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

- Dicyclomine: Acts as an anticholinergic by blocking muscarinic receptors on smooth muscle, leading to muscle relaxation and relief from spasms.
- Paracetamol: Inhibits prostaglandin synthesis in the CNS, providing analgesic and antipyretic
 effects.

Indications:

- Abdominal colic and cramps
- Gastrointestinal spasm
- Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS)
- Dysmenorrhea
- · Spastic conditions of the urinary or biliary tract

Dosage & Administration:

- Adults: 1 tablet 2-3 times daily after meals or as directed by the physician
- Not recommended in children unless prescribed
- · Do not exceed the prescribed dosage

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to dicyclomine, paracetamol, or any excipients
- · Glaucoma, myasthenia gravis, obstructive uropathy, or gastrointestinal obstruction
- Severe hepatic impairment

Warnings & Precautions:

- · Use with caution in patients with hepatic or renal impairment
- Avoid alcohol and other hepatotoxic agents during treatment
- Prolonged use should be monitored to avoid hepatotoxicity from paracetamol
- Not recommended during pregnancy and lactation unless advised by a physician

Drug Interactions:

- · Alcohol and other CNS depressants may potentiate dicyclomine's anticholinergic effects
- Increased risk of liver toxicity with excessive paracetamol or in combination with enzyme inducers

Adverse Effects:

- · Drowsiness, dry mouth, dizziness, constipation
- In rare cases: hepatotoxicity (due to paracetamol), blurred vision, or urinary retention

Storage:

- Store below 25°C in a dry, dark place
- · Protect from light and moisture
- · Keep out of reach of children
