Composition: Each tablet contains:

• Sultamicillin Tosilate: 375 mg

Description:

Sultamicillin is a combination of two antibiotics, Ampicillin and Sulbactam, which work synergistically to treat a variety of bacterial infections. Sulbactam acts as a betalactamase inhibitor, protecting Ampicillin from bacterial enzymes that might otherwise inactivate it.

Sultamicillin Tosilate is primarily used in the treatment of infections caused by susceptible bacteria, including respiratory, urinary, and skin infections.

Indications:

This medication is indicated for the treatment of infections caused by susceptible organisms, including:

- Urinary Tract Infections: Cystitis, pyelonephritis, and other urinary tract infections.
- Skin and Soft Tissue Infections: Abscesses, cellulitis, and other soft tissue infections.
- Intra-abdominal Infections: Including peritonitis.

Mechanism of Action:

- Severe gastrointestinal issues: Persistent diarrhea or watery stools, possibly

associated with Clostridium difficile infection.

Drug Interactions:

- Anticoagulants (e.g., warfarin): May increase the risk of bleeding. Close monitoring is advised when using these medications together.
- Allopurinol: Concurrent use may increase the risk of skin rashes.
- Probenecid: May increase Sultamicillin blood levels by reducing renal excretion.

Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place at 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F).
- Keep the tablet in its original packaging to protect from light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.
