Composition:

Each hard gelatin capsule contains:

- **Tacrolimus IP 0.25 mg**
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Description:

Tacrofoli 0.25 Capsule contains **Tacrolimus**, an immunosuppressant used to prevent organ transplant rejection and manage certain autoimmune conditions. It helps in **suppressing abnormal immune responses by inhibiting T-lymphocyte activation**.

Indications:

Indicated for:

- Prevention of organ transplant rejection (kidney, liver, heart)
- Management of autoimmune diseases as prescribed by the physician

It helps in **reducing immune-mediated damage and maintaining graft function**.

Dosage & Administration:

Dose should be individualized according to physician's guidance.

Capsules should be swallowed whole with water, preferably on an empty stomach.

Pharmacological Action:

Tacrolimus binds to FK-binding protein (FKBP), inhibiting calcineurin. This prevents transcription of interleukin-2 and other cytokines, thereby reducing T-cell activation and immune response.

Side Effects:

Mild tremors, headache, or gastrointestinal discomfort may occur in some patients.

Warnings & Precautions:

- Monitor kidney function, blood pressure, and blood glucose during therapy.

- Avoid live vaccines during treatment.
 - Regular blood level monitoring is recommended to prevent toxicity.
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Drug Interactions:

May interact with CYP3A4 inhibitors or inducers, nephrotoxic drugs, and other immunosuppressants.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place. Protect from light and moisture.
Keep out of reach of children.
