Information For the User Tacrolimus 0.1% Cream

Therapeutic Category: Immunomodulator - Calcineurin Inhibitor

Composition:

Each gram contains:

Tacrolimus IP – 0.1% w/w

Excipients – q.s.

Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Tacrolimus is a macrolide lactone and a potent calcineurin inhibitor. It binds to the FK506 binding protein (FKBP-12) and forms a complex that inhibits calcineurin phosphatase. This action suppresses the transcription of pro-inflammatory cytokines such as IL-2, IL-3, IL-4, TNF-α, and interferon-gamma. When applied topically, it modulates local immune response in the skin, reduces inflammation, and alleviates symptoms associated with atopic dermatitis and other inflammatory dermatoses.

Indications:

- Moderate to severe atopic dermatitis in adults and children above 2 years
- Lichen planus
- Vitiligo (off-label)
- Chronic eczema or steroid-responsive dermatoses requiring non-steroidal treatment

Dosage & Administration:

- Apply a thin layer to the affected skin area twice daily or as directed by the physician
- · Gently rub until completely absorbed
- Wash hands before and after application (unless treating the hands)
- Avoid use with occlusive dressings unless prescribed

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Tacrolimus or any components of the formulation
- Active untreated skin infections (bacterial, fungal, or viral)
- Immunocompromised patients (unless under specialist supervision)

Warnings & Precautions:

- · Avoid exposure to sunlight or UV light on treated areas; use sunscreen or protective clothing
- · Not for use in children under 2 years of age
- · Do not apply to mucosal areas, open wounds, or infected lesions
- · Discontinue if signs of hypersensitivity or irritation appear
- Long-term safety of topical Tacrolimus is not fully established; periodic monitoring may be required

Drug Interactions:

- Avoid concurrent use with other immunosuppressive agents
- · Minimal systemic absorption, but caution advised if used with systemic calcineurin inhibitors

Adverse Effects:

- · Common: Burning sensation, itching, redness at application site
- Less common: Skin tingling, acne, folliculitis, viral infections (e.g., herpes simplex)
- · Rare: Hypersensitivity, lymphadenopathy

Storage:

- Store below 25°C in a dry place
- · Protect from direct sunlight
- · Keep out of reach of children
