- Thiamine deficiency can cause weight loss and anorexia, confusion, short term memory loss and other mental signs and symptoms; muscle weakness; and cardiovascular symptoms (such as an enlarged heart) washington, DC, National Academy press; 1998 Upto 80% of people with chronic alcoholism develop thiamine deficiency because ethanol reduces gastrointestinal absorption of thiamin, stores in the liver and thiamin phosphorylation.
- Thiamine is an essential micronutriens that cannot be made in the body.
- Required for metabolism including that of glucose, amino acids and lipids.
