Therapeutic Indication:

Timpride 1 Tablet is used for the **management of gastrointestinal motility disorders**. It helps in:

- Functional dyspepsia (indigestion)
- Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD)
- Bloating, fullness, and delayed gastric emptying
- Nausea and vomiting caused by gastric stasis

It helps in enhancing gastric motility and improving digestion and stomach comfort.

Mechanism of Action:

- **Cinitapride** acts as a **prokinetic agent** that stimulates serotonin (5-HT4) receptors and blocks dopamine (D2) receptors in the gastrointestinal tract.
- This action accelerates gastric emptying and reduces reflux and bloating by enhancing coordinated gastrointestinal movements.

Dosage & Administration:

- Usually taken **before meals**, as directed by a physician.
- Dose depends on patient condition and response to therapy.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to cinitapride
- Gastrointestinal bleeding or perforation
- Mechanical obstruction of the GI tract

Warnings & Precautions:

- Use with caution in patients with **severe renal or hepatic impairment**.
- Avoid alcohol and CNS depressants while taking this medication.
- Not recommended during **pregnancy and breastfeeding** unless prescribed.

Possible Side Effects:

- Drowsiness, headache
- Abdominal cramps
- Diarrhea or constipation
- Rarely, mild tremors or restlessness

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry place, below 25°C, protected from light and moisture.
