Tiotropium Bromide I.P. equivalent to Tiotropium 9 mcg

Description:

Tioprime Inhaler contains Tiotropium, a long-acting anticholinergic bronchodilator used in the management of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and other respiratory conditions. It works by relaxing the muscles around the airways, helping to open the bronchial passages and improve airflow to the lungs. Regular use helps reduce breathing difficulty, wheezing, and shortness of breath.

Indications:

Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)

Chronic bronchitis

Emphysema

Maintenance treatment for airflow obstruction

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be used as directed by the physician.

The inhaler should be used by inhalation into the lungs as prescribed.

Follow proper inhalation technique for effective delivery of the medication.

Pharmacological Action:

Tiotropium is a long-acting muscarinic receptor antagonist that blocks M3 receptors in the airway smooth muscles. This results in bronchodilation and prolonged relaxation of airway muscles, improving airflow and reducing respiratory symptoms.

Side Effects:

Dry mouth

Throat irritation

Cough

Headache

Rare allergic reactions

Precautions & Warnings:

Use under medical supervision only.

Use cautiously in patients with glaucoma or urinary retention.

Not intended for the relief of acute bronchospasm.

Drug Interactions:

May interact with other anticholinergic medications.

Consult physician before using with other inhaled medicines.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a dry place.

Protect from direct sunlight and moisture.

Keep out of reach of children.
