**Composition:**

Each film coated tablet contains:  
Tolperisone Hydrochloride I.P. 450 mg

**Description:**

Tolprist 450 Tablet contains Tolperisone, a centrally acting muscle relaxant used in the management of painful muscle spasms associated with musculoskeletal conditions. It works by reducing excessive muscle stiffness and improving mobility without causing significant sedation. The medication helps relieve muscle pain, improves blood circulation in affected muscles, and supports better movement and functional recovery.

**Indications:**

Painful muscle spasms  
Musculoskeletal disorders  
Cervical and lumbar spondylosis  
Post-traumatic muscle spasm  
Spasticity associated with neurological conditions

**Dosage & Administration:**

Dosage should be taken as directed by the physician.  
Tablet should be swallowed whole with water, preferably after meals.

**Pharmacological Action:**

Tolperisone acts on the central nervous system by inhibiting abnormal reflex activity in the spinal cord. It stabilizes nerve membranes and reduces muscle hyperactivity, resulting in muscle relaxation and relief from pain and stiffness.

Dizziness  
Headache  
Nausea  
Weakness  
Rare allergic reactions

**Precautions & Warnings:**

Use under medical supervision only.  
Use cautiously in patients with hypersensitivity to tolperisone or related compounds.  
Patients experiencing dizziness should avoid driving or operating machinery.

**Drug Interactions:**

May interact with other muscle relaxants and central nervous system depressants.  
Consult physician before using with other medications.

**Storage:**

Store below 25°C in a dry place.  
Protect from light and moisture.  
Keep out of reach of children.
