# Tretics 0.025 Cream

**Brand Name:** Tretics 0.025% Cream

**Dosage Form:** Topical Cream

**Therapeutic Category:** Anti-acne / Keratolytic Agent

## Composition:

Each gram of cream contains:

- Tretinoin IP 0.025%
- Excipients – q.s.

## Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Tretinoin is a vitamin A derivative (retinoid) that modulates epithelial cell growth and differentiation. It promotes the turnover of follicular epithelial cells, reduces comedone formation, and helps in the treatment of acne vulgaris. Tretinoin also stimulates collagen synthesis, improving skin texture and reducing fine wrinkles.

## Indications:

- Treatment of mild to moderate acne vulgaris
- Management of comedonal acne
- Adjunct therapy for photoaged skin to improve skin texture

## Dosage & Administration:

- Apply a thin layer once daily, preferably in the evening, to affected areas after cleansing
- Avoid contact with eyes, lips, and mucous membranes
- Start with lower strength in sensitive skin and gradually increase under physician guidance

## Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Tretinoin or any component of the formulation
- Open wounds, eczema, or sunburned skin

## Warnings & Precautions:

- Use sunscreen during the day as Tretinoin increases photosensitivity
- Avoid simultaneous use of other exfoliating or irritating products unless advised
- Not recommended during pregnancy or lactation unless prescribed by a physician

## Adverse Effects:

- Common: Redness, peeling, dryness, mild burning or stinging
- Rare: Severe irritation, allergic reactions

## Overdose:

- Topical overdose may cause excessive irritation; discontinue use and apply emollients
- Seek medical advice if severe reactions occur

**Storage:**

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place

Protect from light

Keep out of reach of children
