Trimetazidine 20 mg tablet

Trizapime 20 Tablet

Brand Name: Trizapime 20 Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

Trimetazidine Dihydrochloride IP equivalent to Trimetazidine 20 mg

Therapeutic Indication:

Indicated as an add-on therapy for the management of stable angina pectoris in patients inadequately controlled by or intolerant to first-line antianginal agents

Helps reduce frequency of angina attacks and improves exercise tolerance

Also used for supportive treatment in ischemic heart disease

Mechanism of Action:

Trimetazidine is a metabolic anti-ischemic agent

It improves myocardial glucose utilization by inhibiting fatty acid metabolism

This preserves energy production in ischemic cells improves cardiac efficiency and reduces intracellular acidosis and calcium overload during ischemia

Dosage & Administration:

Usual adult dose: one tablet twice or thrice daily or as directed by the physician

Should be taken with meals to improve gastrointestinal tolerance

Dose adjustment may be necessary in elderly patients or those with renal impairment

Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to Trimetazidine or any component of the formulation

Parkinson's disease parkinsonian symptoms tremors restless leg syndrome or other movement disorders

Severe renal impairment (creatinine clearance <30 ml/min)

Warnings & Precautions:

Not recommended for acute angina or unstable angina episodes

Use with caution in elderly patients and those with renal dysfunction

Monitor for movement disorders or neurological symptoms periodically

Discontinue if any extrapyramidal symptoms develop

Side Effects:

Common: dizziness headache abdominal pain nausea vomiting

Less common: rash pruritus diarrhea

Rare: parkinsonism tremor gait disturbance thrombocytopenia agranulocytosis

Storage:

Store in a cool dry and dark place below 25°C

Protect from moisture and direct sunlight

Keep out of reach of children

Packaging:

Trizapime 20 Tablet is available in blister or strip packs
