Composition:

Each tablet contains:

- Sodium Valproate 333 mg
- Valproic Acid 145 mg (Total Valproate Content: 500 mg)

Indications:

Valproate 500 is used in the management of:

- **Epilepsy** (Generalized, Absence, Myoclonic, and Partial Seizures)
